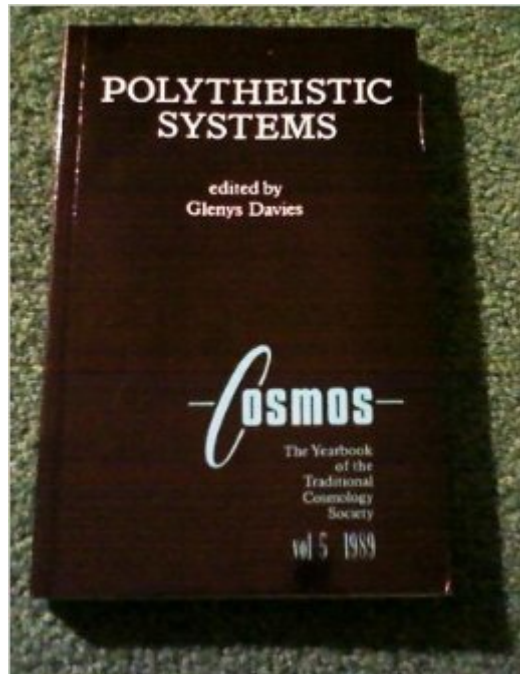

Synopsis

The Yearbook of the Traditional Cosmology Society. This collection of papers looks at polytheistic systems from a multi-disciplinary perspective. Chapters cover a wide range of cultures and religions, from India, Central America, the Classical and Celtic worlds, and the Near East. Elizabeth Baquedano looks at Aztec earth deities; Anthony Shelton discusses Nahuatl and Huichol gods, and there are chapters on the Twins of Macha, the Otomi deities, the Okinawa and Balinese Lombok. Deirdre Green reassesses polytheism in general, Glenys Lloyd-Morgan looks at the particular rite of mirror dedication, while Hilda Davidson traces the origin of hooded men from Roman Britain to the modern garden gnome. The Traditional Cosmology Society was founded in 1984 for the international study of myth, religion, and cosmology. It aims to provide a forum for discussion and to promote interdisciplinary exchange. Glenys Davies is a Lecturer in the Department of Classics, University of Edinburgh.
