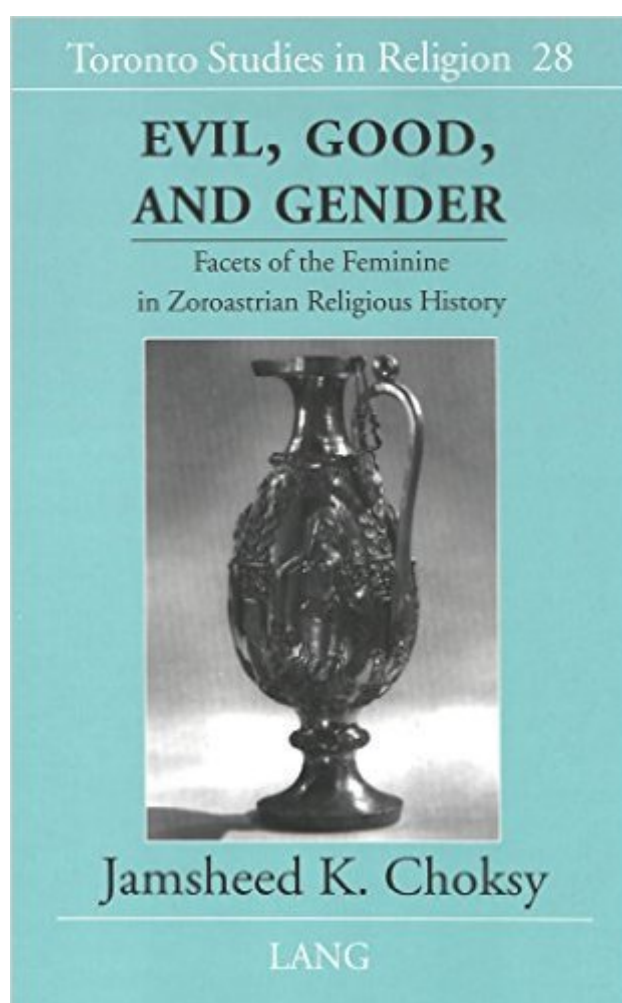


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# Evil, Good, And Gender: Facets Of The Feminine In Zoroastrian Religious History (Toronto Studies In Religion)
