Olly's method for leading you through these short stories is extremely efficient and effective. It's exactly how I recommend my English students get started reading and the method I've used in my own learning.

This is an interesting way to practice Italian that you've learned but have no one to practice with, or even if you just want to keep up with it in general. There are indeed short stories here, and after each one you get the summary of the story in Italian, the summary in English, a glossary with many of the words that were in the story, and a short quiz about the story with the questions and answers in Italian. It makes a great companion book to Italian language learning ebooks, such as Italian: Italian For Beginners: A Practical Guide to Learn the Basics of Italian in 10 Days! by Miguel De Cortes.
