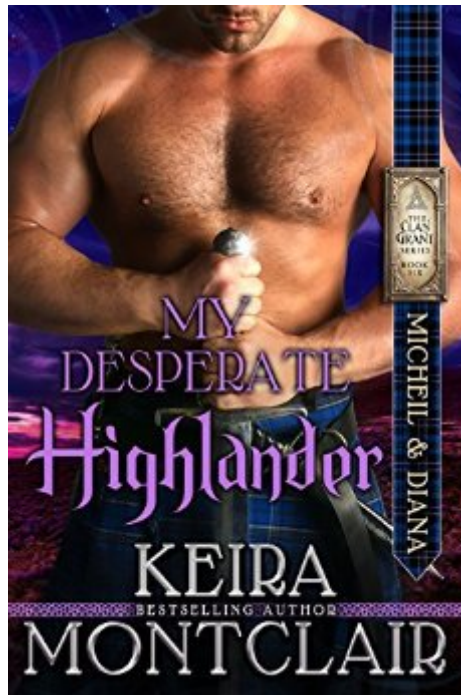


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My Desperate Highlander: Micheil And Diana (Clan Grant Series Book 6)
